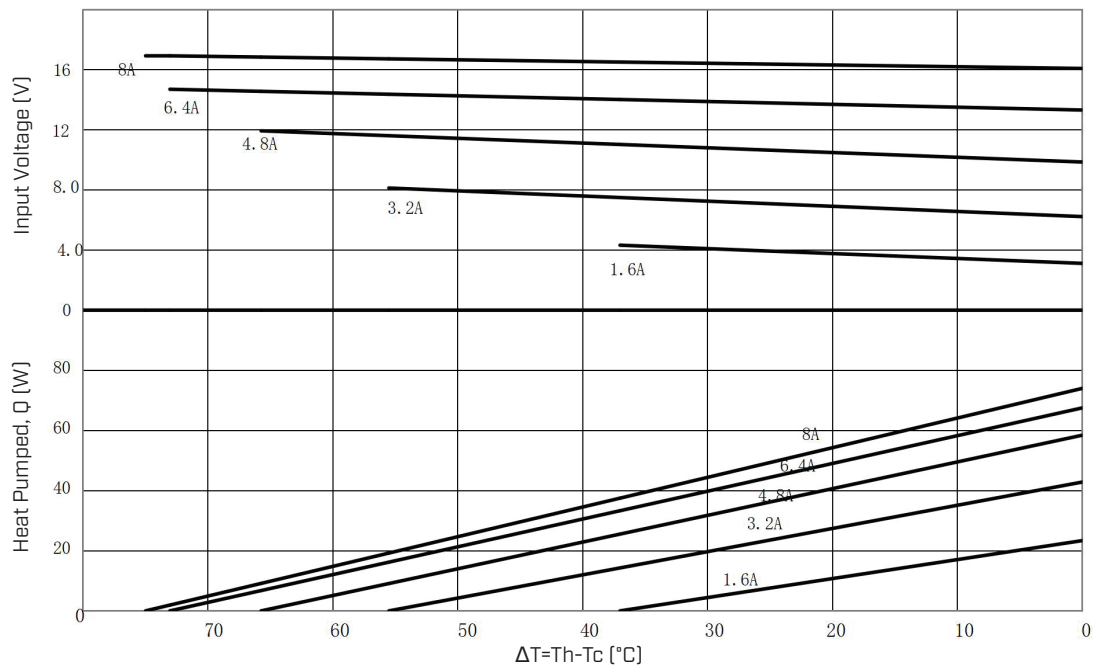

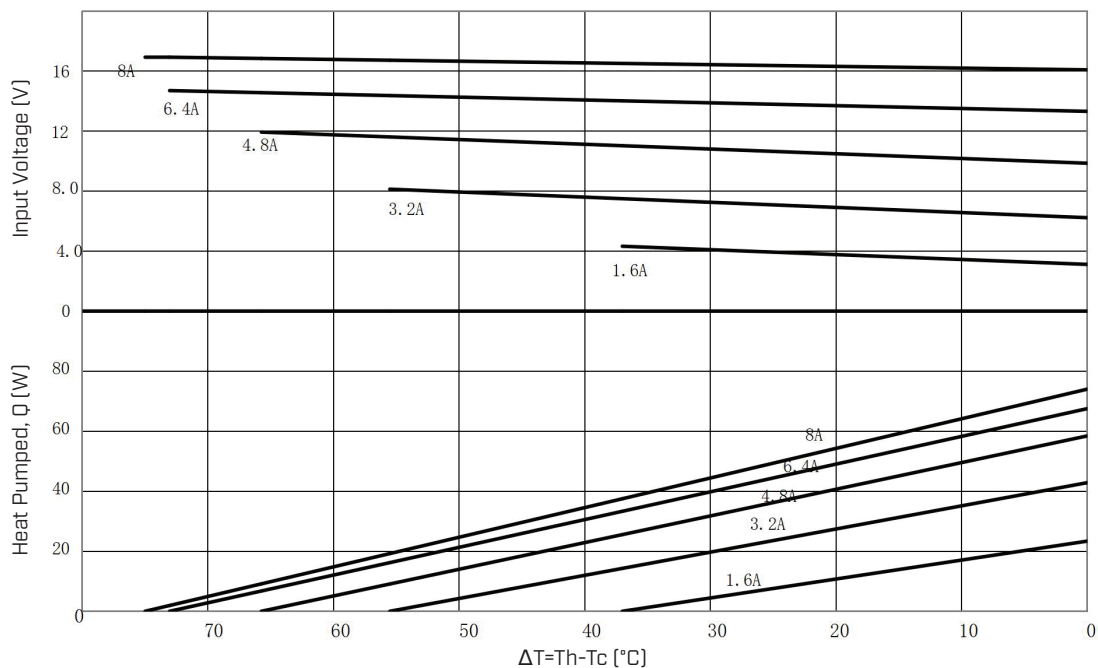


Strip and tin with BiSn solder
